
## ROOM MEASUREMENT guide

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Draw a basic room sketch to show the shape of the room and placement of windows, doors, and wall openings. Add any additional information as needed (e.g. wall opening leads to dining room).
- 2. Clearly label lengths of wall segments, doors, windows, and any other notable architectural elements on your sketch.
- 3. Measure your ceiling height and note it on the sketch.
- 4. Input this information into a program like Homestyler and add furniture to create the space plan for your room.
